Directions to the course: From Santa Fe, take I-25 north to US-285 (Eldorado exit, #290), proceed south on 285 to State Highway 41, turn right on Hwy 41 and go about 16 miles to the top of the hill climbing out of the Galisteo Valley. From Albuquerque, take I-40 east to the middle Moriarty exit (Exit 196), State Highway 41. Take Hwy 41 north, past Stanley about 18 miles to the top of the mesa before dropping into the Galisteo Valley.

Parking: You must park entirely off the pavement!!! Please park on the west side of the road in the small parking area at the top of the hill. If no parking is available there, park single file on the shoulder and OFF THE PAVEMENT.

Course Description: The start/finish is at the top of the hill near mile marker 46. The portion of the course north of the start is rolling, while the portion south of it is flat. There is one slightly more significant climb out of the Galisteo Valley. The area usually offers up plenty of wind to make things interesting. The finish will be just south of the top of the climb out of the Galisteo Valley.

The 65-mile race will go south towards Moriarty, turn near mile marker 30, go north to about the 285/41 intersection, and return to the finish just past the top of the hill. The 50-mile race will go south towards Moriarty, turn near mile marker 30, and go north to just south of the village of Galisteo, and return to the finish. The 30-mile race will go south towards Moriarty, then turn near mile marker 30, and return to the finish.

Race Day Registration from 8:00–8:30am ONLY (Race will run rain or shine)
 Registration is \$30. One-day licenses are \$10, and can be used only to race men category 5, women category 4, and junior events. All others must have an annual license. Juniors race free, but must have a license or purchase a one-day license. \$1 from each entry goes to support NMBRA.
